

## **Europe v USA Match 2019 - Technical Regulations**

### **1701. PROMOTION AND RIGHTS**

- 1701.1. All rights in and arising from Europe vs USA Match 2019 are the exclusive property of European Athletics, except stated otherwise in the Match Agreement between European Athletics and USA Track & Field. These rights include but are not limited to rights of ownership, marketing, advertising, broadcasting, filming, televising and all or any other means of exploitation. No other entity may exercise any of these rights without the written consent of European Athletics, except stated otherwise in the Match Agreement between European Athletics and USA Track & Field.
- 1701.2.1. For the strict and limited purpose of promoting European Athletics, the sport of Athletics or any particular athletics competitions and for non-commercial use, European Athletics may without charge and on a worldwide basis use any images of European athletes in any media at or in conjunction with any athletics competitions in which European Athletics has an ownership interest, including Europe vs USA Match 2019.
- 1701.2.2. Should an athlete not agree with such procedure, a written letter stating the reasons for this opposition shall be sent to the European Athletics Headquarters in Lausanne two (2) weeks prior to the respective event.
- 1701.2.3. Furthermore, any competition images from any European Athletics events shall not be used by the athletes for commercial use. However, the use of event images on social media sites, as long as there is no commercial purpose, is not prohibited.
- 1701.3. The athletes acknowledge and agree to European Athletics' use of the personal data, included but not limited to the first name, name, date of birth, club affiliation, results, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation Act on Data Protection, as well as disclosure of athletes' personal data to European Athletics affiliates, employees, agents, representatives and third party organisations worldwide for the purpose of promotion of the sport and to provide statistics.
- 1701.3.1. Athletes further acknowledge and agree to European Athletics' use of the personal data if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that any such preservation or disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with legal process, enforce these Regulations, respond to claims that any content violates the rights of third parties, or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of other users or the public.

## 1702. PROGRAMME, STRUCTURE AND SCORING

1702.1. Europe vs USA Match 2019 shall be over two days on 9-10 September 2019 at Dynamo Stadium in Minsk, Belarus, in accordance with the applicable Competition, Advertising, Doping and other relevant Rules and Regulations of the European Athletics and International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF).

1702.2. The programme shall comprise the following events:

Running	100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 3000m, 110m hurdles(m), 100m hurdles(w), 400m hurdles, 3000m steeplechase, 4x100m relay, Medley Relay (mixed 200m-200m-400m-800m, with 1 woman and 1 man running 200 m in the order defined by each team, and then a woman 400m and a man at 800m)

1702.4. Four (4) athletes from each Team shall participate in each individual event and two (2) relay teams from each Team shall participate in each relay events.

1702.5. Men and Women will score together for each Team, and the winner of each individual event and each relay shall score 9 points, the second will score 7 points, the third will score one fewer, and so on. Athletes or relay teams with no valid performance, disqualified or not finishing shall not score.

If two or more athletes tie for a place in any event, the attributable points shall be divided equally between them.

The Team having the highest aggregate number of points shall be the winner of the Match.

If the two Teams have the same aggregate number of points, the tie shall be decided in favour of the Team having the greater number of event winners. If the tie still remains it shall be decided in favour of the Team having the greater number of second places, and so on.

- 1702.6. The Lane Order in track events, with start in separate lanes, and the Starting Order in all other events have been decided by a draw in witness of representatives from European Athletics and the USATF in Monte-Carlo, Monaco, on 1 December 2018. Each Team have been allocated a letter (Europe A and USATF B) which shall determine the Lane Order and the Starting Order in accordance with the chart appended below as Schedule A.

### **1703. ENTRIES AND CONFIRMATION**

- 1703.1. EA and USATF are responsible for the selection and participation of their respective Team in accordance with this Agreement. Only athletes selected by USATF under its rules and regulations are eligible for the USA Team, while the Europe Team can only be composed of athletes affiliated to European Athletics' Member Federations. All participating athletes must be in compliance with the IAAF eligibility rules for this purpose.

Both European Athletics and USATF shall endeavour their best efforts to have their best athletes representing each Team.

- 1703.2. The Teams shall be selected by 19 August 2019 and communicated between the Parties. Not later than 21 August 2019 (14:00 CET), USATF and European Athletics shall provide, via the teams' on-line entry system, a preliminary list of athletes and the numbers of accompanying officials.
- 1703.3. Not later than 1 September 2019 (14:00 CET), USATF and European Athletics shall provide, via the Teams' On-line Entry System, a final list of its athletes, plus the names of accompanying officials. The final list of athletes and accompanying officials shall be supplied in the manner to be prescribed by European Athletics and shall include such details as required by European Athletics, including the names and best performances of each athlete.
- 1703.4. In case of late injuries, replacement of initially entered athletes will be allowed until final confirmation deadline for the first competition day. However, no additional athletes will be accepted, but substitutes only.
- 1703.5. The final confirmation of the athletes to compete shall be made according to the procedures defined in the Team Manual.

### **1706. DOPING CONTROL**

- 1706.1. Doping Controls will be carried out in accordance with IAAF Competition Rules and IAAF Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations. The Sample Collection programme will be overseen by the European Athletics Anti-Doping Delegate. The Organiser will be responsible for organizing the testing. The Sample Collection Programme will consist of both pre- and in-Competition testing

carried out from the official opening of the Team Hotels until the end of the Match. European Athletics is responsible for all costs associated with the Doping Controls excluding tests specifically requested by USATF in writing.

#### **1707. INTERNATIONAL OFFICIALS AND DELEGATES**

1707.1. The European Athletics Executive Board shall appoint the following Delegates and other officiating persons to provide specialist advice and guidance to the organiser:

- 1 Technical Delegate
- 1 Doping Control Delegate
- 6 ITOs IAAF and/or Area Level
- 3 Jury of Appeal Members
- 1 International Starter
- 1 International Photo Finish Judge
- 1 International/European VDM Judge
- 1 OVR (On Venue Results) Liaison
- 1 Event Presentation Consultant
- 1 English speaker Announcer
- 1 Media Delegate

#### **1708. CEREMONIES**

1708.1. The winning team of the Match shall receive the Trophy to be provided by European Athletics.

#### **1709. TECHNICAL RULES**

1709.1. The IAAF Rules will be in force for the Match with the exception of the field events where the following specific regulations will apply:

1709.1.1. There will be three (3) trials in each field event, except in the vertical jumps. Following this, the top six (6) athletes from these trials will advance to the final three (3) rounds. After the fourth (4th) round, the lowest placing athlete, based on all attempts thus far in the competition, will be eliminated. After the fifth (5th) round, the lowest placing athlete, based on all attempts thus far in the competition, will be eliminated. Only four (4) athletes will take a sixth (6th) and final attempt. IAAF Rule 180.22 will apply for ties. The order of trials in the first round will be kept until the 3rd trial. Then the order of the trials in the final rounds will be the reverse order of the ranking after the 3rd round.

1709.1.2. In the vertical jumps the IAAF rule 181.2 shall be respected. Furthermore, each competitor is limited to a maximum of eight (8) attempts throughout the competition. However, no competitor may take more than three (3) attempts at any height during the competition and at which time they would be eliminated from the competition. After the eighth jump he/she may

not jump further unless he/she has won the competition. The time permitted for each attempt shall be 30 seconds in High Jump and 1 (one) minute in Pole Vault except when consecutive attempts are by the same athlete or if only the winner is competing in which case IAAF Rule 180.18 shall apply. The winner of the competition is allowed to continue according to IAAF Rule 181.2. The winner will be allowed to continue at the height he/she was not successful. IAAF Rule 181.8 will apply for placing.

1709.2. Each Team shall compete in the respective Team's official uniform. Advertising or other identification displayed on clothing of athletes must follow IAAF Advertising Regulations.

## **1710. PRIZE MONEY**

1710.1. Individual events:

The Organiser shall award the following Prize Money in each of the individual events:

1. €7,000
2. €5,000
3. €4,000
4. €3,000
5. €2,000
6. €1,000
7. €500
8. €500

1710.2. Relay events:

The Organiser shall award the following Prize Money in each of the relay events (amount to be divided among the competing members of the relay team):

1. €6,000
2. €4,000

1710.3. Payment of Prize Money

Each athlete that is eligible for Prize Money shall fill in and sign the Award Form, which will be available as an appendix to the Team Manual, and thereby inform to whom (Authorised Representative, personally or to the Member Federation) and to which bank account the Prize Money shall be paid. The Prize Money shall be paid to applicable bank account no later than 15 October 2019. Prize Money for each relay shall be paid to USATF or EA, as applicable, to be distributed to its athletes according to procedures adopted by that organisation.
